- Changes in scale and scope of international terrorism activity

Information Security Attributes

- Confidentiality – ensuring that information is not disclosed to unauthorized parties
- Integrity – ensuring that information does not get altered or destroyed
- Availability – ensuring that systems work and service is not denied to authorized users
